## FOCUS AREA

Apparel

The selected focus area for this garment apparel is as a statement evening garment and as a high fashion statement on the runway.

Inspired by the corsetry from the Victorian era Christian Dior, Alexander McQueen (17) inspired the beadwork and dark, confident energy of this MTP. Thierry Mugler inspired the pleated French draping of the silk georgette overlay.

The fluid drape of the Corisia fabric skirt is inspired by the Grecian Chiton and Madeleine Vionnet, which creates harmony.

The contrasting textures of each fabric captivates an aesthetic design of movement and rhythm, whilst the harmonizing colours simultaneously create a confident and feminine design.

The asymmetry of the bodice creates a unique, elegant appearance, whilst the elongated shape emphasises the feminine figure.
