

## **NBCS Sport Code of Conduct**

NBCS Code of Conduct is a set of guidelines which serve to support our school values. School and Representative Sport at NBCS is a privilege not a right, an opportunity to be part of a team, build culture, grow in resilience and enjoy success!

## **Commitment to Sport**

- 1. Students to be committed to their sport for the season or term including all sessions/training and matches.
- 2. Students in Year 7-10 must select two weekly school sports they are happy to participate in for the term. Once sports are allocated there will be no changes.
- 3. Students who are trialling for Representative Sports must register to trial and attend the trial to be considered.
- 4. Students will be on time to sport sessions/training and matches.
- 5. Students will adhere to all dates for completion of sport choices each term/transport arrangements, returning of uniforms and other organisational procedures.
- 6. Students are to wear the full NBCS sport/team uniform for the duration of the day including to and from a venue. Non NBCS jumpers/hoodies are not to be worn, students who are not in full uniform will not play on the day.

## Commitment to NBCS Vision Love Learning

For students to be involved in sport at NBCS it is their responsibility to

- Students who are exhibiting a pattern of concern, and failing to maintain NBCS Secondary Behaviour Expectations may be excluded from representing NBCS. This will be at the discretion of the Head of Sport, in Conjunction with the Director of Wellbeing and Head of Secondary.
- 2. Ensure they catch up on work missed while representing the school.
- 3. See their teacher prior to their sport commitment to ensure assessments are not missed and steps are in place to re sit.

## Respect

- 1. Students will always play or participate in a positive and sportsmanlike manner and respect their teammates, opposition, coaches, officials and spectators.
- 2. Students will always play in the spirit of the rules and abide by the official's decisions in all circumstances. Any student displaying a negative response towards an official ruling will be removed from the game.
- 3. Criticism/sledging of the opposition, coaches, supporters or teammate will not be tolerated. Retaliation to opposition sledging is not accepted.
- 4. No deliberate acts of violence or foul play will be tolerated.
- 5. Excessive or inappropriate language should not be used in any circumstances.
