The **Fashion Program** is an exciting day program designed specifically for students in Years 8-11. The students who participate in this program do not need any prior manufacturing or fashion illustration skills. The goals are to have students learn how to draw fashion images using free hand and digital methods. Students will complete a garment and understand the elements and principles of design.
