Medical Form - Please complete via your PADI E-Learning profile. If you are not able to access it online, complete the form you can <u>find here</u> and send it to Dive Centre Manly info@divesydney.com.au

- A YES answer to any of the questions would indicate that you have a pre-existing condition that may need to be assessed by a doctor for you to dive.
- If you have no pre-existing conditions, diving in Australia does not require a dive medical.

You can visit your own doctor, or our local dive doctor in Manly is Dr Levenston at <u>South Steyne Medical Centre</u>. Alternatively, you can find a dive physician by visiting <u>www.spums.org.au</u>.

Please note, if you require a medical and do not provide us with one in time for your course, unfortunately, there will be no refund, and you cannot participate in the course.

• Should you fail your dive medical, a refund minus a \$25 administration fee will be given. If you have already activated the e-learning account, this section of the course is non-refundable at the cost of \$200.

Preparation for the program

For your comfort and the smooth running of the program, please stop by the shop by Thursday, 11th May, to confirm your wetsuit and boot size. Our shop is in the heart of Manly at 10 Belgrave Street.

1. Knowledge Development (This is the online component and must be completed by Thursday, 11th May)

You must complete all six sections, including all knowledge reviews, quizzes and the final assessment, before the start of your course. Unfortunately, **you will be unable to start your course if this has not been completed**, and may forfeit your course fee. Daily program

Day 1 - Monday 15th May - Confined Water Dives

Meet at 9:00 am at Terrey Hills Swim centre - https://goo.gl/maps/FDtcBymcqZqjq4A16

Session starts @ 9:30am - 3:30pm (including lunch break)

This is what it's all about – diving. You'll develop basic scuba skills in the pool. The basic scuba skills you learn during your certification course will help you become familiar with your scuba gear and become an underwater explorer. Some of the essential skills you learn include:

- Setting up your scuba gear.
- How to clear water out of your mask.
- Entering and exiting the water.
- Buoyancy control.
- Basic underwater navigation.
- Safety procedures.

You'll practice these skills with an instructor until you're comfortable. When you're ready, it's time for your underwater adventure to begin at an open water dive site.



Day 2 & 3 - Tuesday 16th May & Wednesday 17th May - Open Water Dives

Meet at 8:45 am at Manly Life Saving Club - https://goo.gl/maps/Mhtt8U49aYA3LBnX9

Students will walk around to Shelley beach for 9:30 am - 2:00 pm Dives (TUESDAY - Dives 1 & 2 of the Open Water Course, WEDNESDAY - Dives 3 & 4 of the Open Water Course)

2.30 pm Leave Shelly Beach to walk back to Manly Surf Club

After your confined water dives, you'll head to "open water" where you and your instructor will complete your compulsory training over four dives, over two days. On these dives you'll get to explore the underwater world. You'll apply the skills you've learned in confined water while enjoying what the local environment has to offer.

Day 4 & 5 - Thursday 18th May

At the end of your 5 days, you will be a certified PADI Junior Open Water Scuba Diver and will have gained your ticket to a lifetime of adventure. An instructor or Divemaster will lead these fun dives and allow you to see more of the fantastic underwater world surrounding you here on the Northern Beaches.

Divers under 18 - Please note that divers under 18 must have their medical and liability paperwork co-signed by a parent or guardian. We must receive all paperwork by Thursday, May 11th.

Your course will be lots of fun, but you will be tired. Ensure you get all your homework done in time and get an early night before the start to ensure you can get the most from your course.
